Why do we need to come to school?

- ◆ To learn new things about the world and gain lifelong skills
- Being part of a group helps us to get on well with others and make friends
- Educational visits help us to learn about the world outside school
- Taking part in clubs and teams is fun and helps us to play together and to get better at what we do
- Being at school every day improves our chances of getting a job or going to college and university when we get older
- It's the law

What happens if you don't come to school?

- You don't learn as well and you could fall behind with your learning
- You don't get to make as many friends
- You miss out on special days, celebrations, educational visits, school clubs and team

- ♦ Your parents/carers could get fined for not sending you to school
